

## **Emergency Research Fund**

This research fund is to support research that you need to conduct quickly. For example, you have a Revise and Resubmit that asks you to collect more data.

## Eligibility

All current College of Journalism and Communications graduate students in good standing are eligible.

## **General Information**

- Rolling Deadline: This fund remains available each year until it's spent.
- Process: Please submit proposals by email to Marcia DiStaso at mdistaso@ufl.edu.
- Amount: The total amount available is \$1,000. Awards are typically funded around \$500.
- Timeframe: Projects must be completed within one year.

## **Proposal**

Please submit a short proposal that includes:

- 1. Project title
- 2. Description of the project and its significance. Please specify the overall research question your project will address and why timeliness is an important factor.
- 3. Team members, including title and affiliation.
- 4. Methods/procedures. In this section, discuss how this funding will improve the quality of the research.
- 5. Proposed budget items. Please list items in order of priority for funding. Examples of allowed expenses: Travel to data collection site, survey sample, participant recruiting, etc. If there are other expenses not covered by the proposed budget, please identify how these financial needs might be met.
- 6. Provide a justification for why this is an emergency.
