Namely, the college's exit survey shows our students seem less likely to have completed an internship or immersion experience upon graduation. Some initial potential causes and solutions were discussed. Some are tied to our curriculum discussion revisions, particularly for the management, and media and society tracks. Frey will send Coche the exit survey data to share with faculty. Coche will contact Graham and Frey again when our curriculum revisions have been approved by the college.

### 3. Spiro Kiousis Check-In

CJC Executive Associate Dean Spiro Kiousis came to provide updates about the college and answer any potential questions from the faculty. The main topics discussed were ACEJMC accreditation, the sunset of Digital Measures, protocols regarding countries of concern, ongoing personnel searches, and university strategic funding.
