On October 10, 2023, the committee chair Kember met with Josh Merrill and discussed classroom technology and the need to upgrade some classrooms controlled by CJC.

- The ambition is a scale down version of the Atlas Lab technology standards.
- WEIM3032 technological challenges were discussed
 - Issues with connectivity were discussed
 - Cumbersome connectivity for Zoom participants
 - Podium access is managed by UF Tech
 - AV side of that room uses Creston

During the academic year the committee advised on the following areas:

- The technology of WEIM3032 updates, along with a change in layout and the addition of large monitors and better connectivity for that room.
- Upgrades for computer labs, for which new computers and monitors replaced aged equipment along with maintaining access to printers from these rooms, and after consultation with faculty, the decision was to keep access to them from the labs.
- Toner storage and replacement for faculty and staff printers was discussed to streamline this process. Xerox printers are maintained by a company, and they automatically send tonner requests. A separate company provides support for printers that TAG Manages. A final decision on this process was not made.
