COVID-19 Update

- Kiousis said the positivity rate in Alachua County is 6% but 2% at UF. By Jan. 10, all students taking classes on campus will be tested. He suggested Chairs have a plan in place for instructors who get COVID.
- Summer, physical distancing limits will still be in place.

Spring Semester

- Kiousis said that for Spring, both face-to-face and online are being registered equally.
- DiStaso said faculty are concerned about logistics with sick students and faculty.
- Kiousis reported that CJC has two vacant faculty lines, ADV and PUR.
- He also said there are two positions that will be opened from retirements. CJC will wait to fill those until there is a better sense of the budget.
- Two AI lines will be filled by new Managing Director of CTMT.

- McFarlin said there is an acceptance for Managing Director of CTMT, paperwork pending for hire.
- Kiousis recognized McFarlin's last Deans and Chairs meeting and thanked her.
