Hub Brown called the meeting to order at 2:01 p.m.

Office Schedule

- Kiousis reminded chairs to keep to approved schedules for their offices. Reynolds reminded everyone to have approved alternative workplace agreements on file as needed.

UFHR Update

- Reynolds mentioned agreement with ASME for 3% increase, and UFF. 1.5% across the board, and 1.5% merit pool for in-unit faculty. Kiousis reminded managers that the college doesn't want to see across-the-board merit increases. Aug. 30, employees will be able to see raises in myUFL.
- UF is raising minimum wage to \$10 per hour.
- Reynolds discussed new Bill that has passed regarding bonuses and incentive programs.

PATH/Knight Division/Advising

- Brown discussed how students move through the institution and working on better coordination.
- Distinctive roles of Knight and OCCP.
- Hosting a meeting to discuss how that path should go for students and reduce any confusion.
- Increase availability and prominence of internships. Make more real-world experiences available for more students.

- Spiker and Kiousis also discussed Covid-19 logistics.

- Wright mentioned that CJC has supplies for faculty of surgical and N-95 masks, and hand sanitizer.
- Kiousis mentioned Gator Evaluations has done an in-depth analysis.
- Wright mentioned Neilsen survey, good news about our stations.
